Dear CN Labeling Program Participant,

As of January 18, 2010, the operation of the Child Nutrition (CN) Label Program shifts from being handled by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA), Food and Nutrition Service to the Agricultural Marketing Service (AMS), Processed Products Branch (PPB). As part of the operational shift, AMS will charge a service payment for each label reviewed. Accounts will be invoiced for each label once the service has been provided.

Service Agreement

Label applications submitted after December 31, 2009, shall be assessed a service payment of \$92.00 per hour, with a minimum charge of one hour per label. "Rush" label reviews shall be assessed a service payment of \$184.00 for the first hour, and \$92.00 for each additional hour. After the first hour of service, payment for service shall be assessed at increments of 15 minutes. By signing this agreement, the applicant for CN label review agrees to pay the USDA for the requested service within the due date specified on the invoice.
