## Surveys for July Deliveries Due By March 15, 2004

For your information, we have released the following surveys for July deliveries (Adjustment Code A) that can be applied to SY 2004 Schools and CACF entitlement or FY 2004 SFSP, AAA, and NPE:

- 10-G-23 Bulk Turkey
- 07-G-22 Bulk Chicken (chix chill and chix chill large)
- 02-G-08 Bulk Eggs (whole bulk)
- 01-G-25 Beef Coarse
- 02-G-25 Beef 40 and Patties

These surveys will be available for input in ECOS on 12 Feb, and due/close on 15 March 04. As a reminder, in ECOS you can review planned orders (not yet purchased) and entitlement balances to determine whether or not you should order from these surveys to utilize your state's remaining entitlement dollars. Any remaining entitlement dollars (or overages) will rollover into the next year.
