

Employment & Training Pledge States

Currently 18 States have “pledged” to offer every applicant or recipient Able-Bodied Adult without Dependents (ABAWD) subject to the three-month time limit on participation a qualifying education, training, or workfare opportunity. If the client fulfills the requirements of his or her education, training, or workfare component, he or she can continue to receive benefits. Each of the 18 States receives a share of the \$20 million set aside in the Farm Bill to fund employment and training services for this population.
